Dr Guy Sisson qualified from Guy's and St Thomas' Hospital in 1999 and gained membership of the Royal College of Physicians (MRCP) in 2004 and subsequently was elected as a fellow of the college on 2018. His principle research interest is the diagnosis and management of irritable bowel syndrome and it is in recognition of this research that he was awarded a MD(res) by Kings College London.

In 2012 Dr Sisson was appointed to my NHS Consultant Post at Darent Valley Hospital. He is accredited as a bowel Cancer screening Colonoscopist. Dr Sisson practices all areas of Gastroenterology including:

Dyspepsia; Gastroesophageal reflux disease (GORD); general hepatology; functional disorders including irritable bowel syndrome (IBS) and inflammatory bowel disease (Crohn's and ulcerative colitis).

Dr Guy Sisson offers a full range of diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopy including upper (OGD) and lower (colonoscopy) endoscopic procedures. He is accredited with the National Bowel Cancer Screening programme to undertake screening colonoscopy.
