Mr Jain has been the Trauma Director for the NHS Trust and until recently has been the Clinical Director for Trauma & Orthopaedics at Medway Maritime Hospital NHS Foundation Trust.

In 2019, he has been awarded Clinical Excellence Award by the NHS Trust for his genuine efforts in improving patient care and supporting teaching and training of young surgeons.
