Mr Connell specialises in the symptoms of the menopause including vaginal atrophy and hormonal replacement therapy (HRT).

He is an expert in the use of new and innovative techniques which are used to manage prolapse and

continence. He introduced laparoscopic subtotal hysterectomies (day-case hysterectomies) to local hospitals over 15 years ago and these techniques are used to reduce complications of treatment and to improve clinical outcomes.

Mr Connell is committed to training and research and is widely published in Obstetrics and Gynaecology.
